Library Director's Report

Personnel/Professional Development:

Breanna Dittert is our Cowley Connect Community Coordinator. She started last month, and this AmeriCorps
(American Connection Corps) position is in collaboration with Winfield Public Library and was funded in part my
Legacy Foundation. Her focus will be on county resource sharing and digital access and skills assistance. She is
working heavily with various community organizations, especially RISE Cowley, and as part of a larger effort to
address the lack of digital equity in our area.

Facilities & Grounds:

• The elevator work is complete. We just need to connect to the phone line.

Budget/Finance:

• Preliminary discussions with City representatives have addressed our continued lack of funding as requested by the Library Board. So far it looks as though the City would be able to help address some funding gaps next year (especially if our ballot measure passes). Additionally, there might be an avenue to address funding gaps in the first half of 2026 until our first tax distributions from the new district are received.

Collection/Circulation:

We are partnering with Winfield Public Library and other service organizations for the upcoming DOCK grant which
addresses digital literacy and digital skill sets for Kansans. A larger coalition as well as letters of support from other

based on similar work to what Breanna is currently doing.
